"Hungry Fungus" pendant with Anke Humpert

Supply list:

Polymer Clay:

1 pack Premo Accent Translucent, 1 pack Premo Black, 1 pack Premo color of your choice.

The clay will be provided by Polyform Products!

Basic polymer clay tool box:

- A clay machine,
- A smooth even work surface, like a tile or a sheet of glass.
- A blade
- An acrylic roller
- An Exacto knife or a thin craft knife
- A round cookie cutter (3 inch in diameter)
- A needle tool
- Parchment or deli paper
- A ruler
- Index cards to bake your pieces on.

Additional material:

- Alcohol inks in metallic or iridescence colors (contrasting to your clay color of choice). I like Ranger's Adirondack Inks, but that is my personal preference.
- Cotton swaps or micro brush.
- Extruder with an assortment of shaped discs (we need of round holed discs, various sizes!).
- Texturing tools (embossing tools with ball tips)
- Acrylic paints (color that goes well with your claycolor of choice, plus white).
- Cosmetic sponge wedges (small size!)
- Kitchen paper towels.
- Small brush and water container.
- Wooden bowls (they are a special kind of bowl, I will bring them for the class and also for sale.)

Metal tools:

- Jewellery pliers (at least a flush cutter, round nosed pliers and flat nose pliers)
- Wire (I like to use silver coated wire in gauge 18 or higher/ 1mm)
- Metal chain for the necklace, at least 20 inch long!
- Jumprings and a clasp.
