

Picture Perfect Pods Materials List

Pasta machine, tempered glass or tile work surface,

Blades: stiff blade such as an Amaco or Kato Nu-Blade

Small lucite roller (1/4 to 1/2 inch)

Small hand drill (1/16" or 3/32"),

Wooden or plastic knife and/or needle tool

Mop brush (a soft, full type of paint or makeup blending brush) and a small detail paintbrush

Index cards

Baby wipes infused with alcohol and deli wrap

2 paper towels,

Polyfil batting to bake on

Cornstarch

Optional: neck cord

Polymer Clay: (Kato Clay is preferred, but leached Premo will work fine as well)

- 2 oz white, 2 oz color for pods, 1 oz color to shift the color of the blend (For example: 2 oz Violet, 2 oz white, 1 oz magenta)
- 2 oz black, 2 oz green, tiny bit translucent, tiny bit of alizarin crimson (for leaf green if you are using Premo)
- 3-4 oz well blended scrap clay for pod bases

All clay should be conditioned and ready to go.
