

Hooray for Polywood! Materials List

Pasta machine, large ceramic tile or tempered glass work surface, roller

Blades: Stiff sharp blade such as the Kato Nublade, ripple blade, X-acto knife

Needle tool and wooden skewer

Ball stylus(es)

Corn starch

Index cards

60 grit sandpaper

15 sheets of plain white paper

Mop brush (a soft, full type of paint or makeup brush) and small paint brush

Small nail cleaning brush with stiff bristles

2 paper towels

Baby wipes infused with alcohol and deli wrap

IF YOU HAVE THEM: bring a few Kemper or other small cutters, pendant shape cutters, pattern cutting scissors, and paper punches. **This can easily become an "everything but the kitchen sink" type of class.** Resist the urge and just bring a few cutters, pattern cutting scissors, stamps, and/or paper punches. You can borrow mine and share with others

Premo clay colors to bring: one 2 oz. block each of Ecu, White, Raw Sienna, Burnt Umber, Black, Beige, Translucent, and Gold. Bring half blocks of Alizarin Crimson, Copper, and Yellow. Wood colored scraps welcome!

All clay should be conditioned and ready to go.
