## **Supplies list:**

Basic Equipment - Pasta Machine, work surface, plastic or metal rolling rod, and a sharp blade.

Polymer Clay- Primary colors and black and white Clay will be provided, but if you have your favorite colors or ready mixed colors you would like to work with, please bring them.

Clay Extruder (If you have one, bring it, but I will have some to share during class.) For the traditional shibori look, I use the slightly Elongated triangle which is the center disc in the LUCY DISC 1 Set. I will also have some of these to share with the class. However, many playful patterns can be made with other extruder disc shapes.



LC Disk 1

- Shape cutters and or templates for finished pieces (if desired).
- Deli paper
- Plastic container to store and transport canes.
- A slicer tool will be very helpful, if you have one, but is not required. I may bring my Lucy Slicer, or Click a Slice tool to share, so please don't worry if you don't have one.
