- Basic clay tools – pasta machine, blade, work surface, Index cards to work on
- Clay will be provided, mostly Souffle. If you have favorite colors or clays, please bring them. Also, if you have Sculpey LS (Liquid Sculpey) and want to get more familiar with it – bring it!
- The Sculpey tools if you have them
- Paint brushes, acrylic paints (I will have some as well)
- LOTS of baby wipes and a small bottle of clear hand sanitizer
- Instant glue (I'm currently a fan of the Gorilla Glue with the brush – cheapest in craft section of Walmart)
- If you have these bring them: Pan Pastels, alcohol inks, Pearl Ex, alcohol markers, Citadels, molds, stamps, gelli plates (I will have some) – anything you have that you really like but can't figure out how to use it for something!

Special items:

- If you want to get ribbon crimps – Michaels has a great set in the section with the leather cording (or you can go crazy on Amazon like I did!) Or get them here:
